WHAT TO BRING:

You will need the following items in order to complete your 2021-22 FAFSA. If you are considered a dependent student for financial aid purposes, you will also need these items for your parent(s).

- 2019 Federal Tax Return and W2s
- 2019 Untaxed Income Records, such as child support or veteran's non-education benefits
- Information on savings, investments, business assets and farm assets (if applicable)
- Driver's License (if you have one)
- Cell phone (if you have one)
- Social Security Number
- Alien Registration Card or Permanent Resident Card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Date of birth for parents
- Month and year of parents' marriage, divorce, or separation
- FSA ID (if you have one). To create an FSA ID, please visit fsid.ed.gov. Every student and at least one parent if the student is considered a dependent student needs one

It is highly recommended that a dependent student attend the event with a parent so the FAFSA can be submitted that day.
